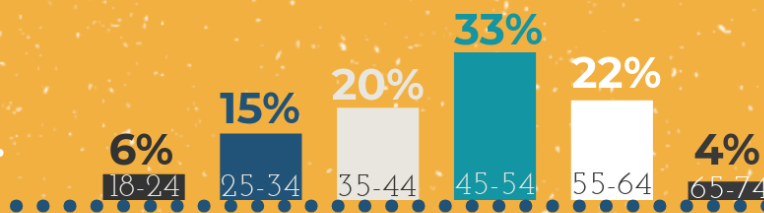

Age.



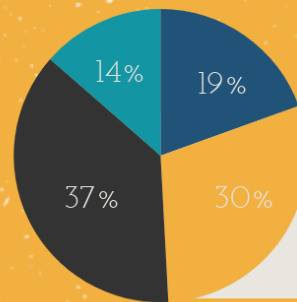
37 participants have been diverted from **Fulton County Jail**, and 81 participants diverted from the **Atlanta City Detention Center**.

Top charges.

- 30% Criminal trespass
- 20% Panhandling
- 16% Urban camping

- 87 had no identification.
- 31 suffer from a chronic illness.

PAD Care Navigators have made 19 connections with job search assistance, readiness, or employment opportunities. Currently, 18 participants are working.

72% of participants were connected with emergency shelter after their referral. We have provided 7 participants with rental assistance and 15 with temporary housing.
